

## 6 Steps To Safety

Once removed from the lightweight carrying cases (A) and laid out on the ground (B) the construction process can be completed in less than ONE MINUTE!

### Step 1

Connect one of the four legs to each side of the two 'H' sections by lifting the 'H' section off the ground slightly, holding the bar tightly and using a 'twisting' motion to roll the leg into the clips.

Lie each completed section on the floor.

**RIGHT WAY UP?** - Ensure that the 'H' section has the top cross bar (with bung in the end) at the top of the leg section to avoid fitting upside down! The lower clip of the 'H' section fits into the collared part of the leg.

You now have 2 completed end sections.

### Step 2

Fit the first of four horizontal cross bars to the TOP of one of the end sections. Lift the 'H' section into a standing position and clip one end of the bar into the TOP of the leg. Let the other end of the cross bar down on the ground while you pick up the other end section ready to connect together.

### Step 3

Lift the other end section onto its feet and bring to a position from which you can bend to pick up the cross bar from the first section and raise it to a horizontal position and then clip into the corresponding position on the second section. The two end sections are now joined together.

### Step 4

(a) Fit the opposite side top cross bar and then (b) the lower cross bar before moving back to the other side.

### Step 5

Fit the cross brace - the longest of the five bars - by clipping first to the LOWER bar of the end section on the OUTSIDE of the small vertical bar of the end section (either end) and then the TOP bar of the opposite end section.

### Step 6

Finally fit the remaining lower cross bar on the same side as the cross brace.
